Holly Bingham Inquiry

The Board reviewed an inquiry from Holly Bingham concerning supervision of an athletic training. She asked if she has a directing physician for her non-clinical setting and will also be working with that same physician in a clinical setting, is there a need for her to be supervised by a physical therapist. The Board determined that, as stated in the Practice Act, she may practice athletic training in a clinical setting only under the direct supervision of a physical therapist. Ms. Bingham also stated that her supervising physician is a chiropractor. The Board determined that a supervising physician must be licensed in the practice of medicine or osteopathy and a chiropractor can only act on a referral basis.

Thomas Shelton Inquiry

An inquiry was received from Thomas Shelton regarding the use of a TENS unit. The Board determined the use of a TENS by a non-licensed individual is a violation of the Practice Act.
